#### REFLECTIONS: ALL I WANT FOR CHRISTMAS

Ubiquitous Christmas tunes of assorted genres have returned to the airwaves. Two songs in particular serve as a starting point for writing this column. The first is Mariah Carey's "holiday classic" *All I Want For Christmas Is You*. For older readers, perhaps you will remember the novelty song supposedly sung by a little boy, *All I Want For Christmas Is My Two Front Teeth* ("how happy I'd be if I could only whistle").
