MAUNDY THURSDAY SERVICE



In commemoration of the Last Supper, when Jesus celebrated His final Passover with His disciples, a Maundy Thursday worship service is planned for St. Mark. We will share a soup supper together on Thursday, April 17th, starting at 6:00 pm in the Family Life Center (FLC), followed by a worship service and communion. All activities will be held at the tables in the FLC. We hope as many of you as possible are able to attend this service.

This year, at the Maundy Thursday service, we will be focusing on the Spiritual Practice of “serving others.” As part of the worship service, a special project, that centers on writing a prayer or note of encouragement to go with much needed socks and baby booties, is planned to benefit the cancer center at San Antonio Medical Center (SAMC) and the pregnancy center here in Boerne. If possible, please bring a new pair of adult-size socks to the Maundy Thursday service.

These socks are a symbol representing when Jesus washed His disciples’ feet before celebrating the Last Supper. He then encouraged the disciples to wash each other’s feet, saying, *“Now that I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also should wash one another’s feet. I have set you an example that you should do as I have done to you. Very truly I tell you, no servant is greater than his master, nor is a messenger greater than the one who sent him. Now that you know these things, you will be blessed if you do them.”* **(John 13:14-17)**

A Solemn Reflection for Holy Week

We are pleased to invite you to join us for our **Tenebrae Service**, a sacred and reflective observance that takes place during Holy Week. Tenebrae, which means "darkness" or "shadows" in Latin, is an ancient Christian tradition that commemorates the final days leading up to the crucifixion of Christ.

Date: Friday, April 18

Time: 6:30 PM

Location: Sanctuary

This service, marked by its deep reverence, involves the gradual extinguishing of candles as we meditate on the suffering and passion of Christ. The Tenebrae Service serves as a profound moment of reflection, inviting us to walk with Christ through His final hours in the shadow of His sacrifice.

Throughout the service, scripture readings, hymns and anthems will guide us through the darkness, while the symbolic extinguishing of light represents the abandonment and sorrow Christ experienced.

We encourage you to come and experience this powerful tradition as we enter into the sacred mystery of Christ's Passion. This is a time for prayer, reflection, and spiritual renewal.

All are welcome. Please feel free to invite family and friends to participate in this special observance.

Note: The Tenebrae Service is a contemplative and solemn event, so we ask that all attendees arrive quietly and remain in silence throughout the service.

May this Holy Week deepen your faith and understanding of Christ's love for us. We look forward to sharing this sacred time with you.

St. Mark is going to host a Dinner Theater on Saturday, September 20th and Sunday, September 21st to benefit a planned international mission trip in 2026.

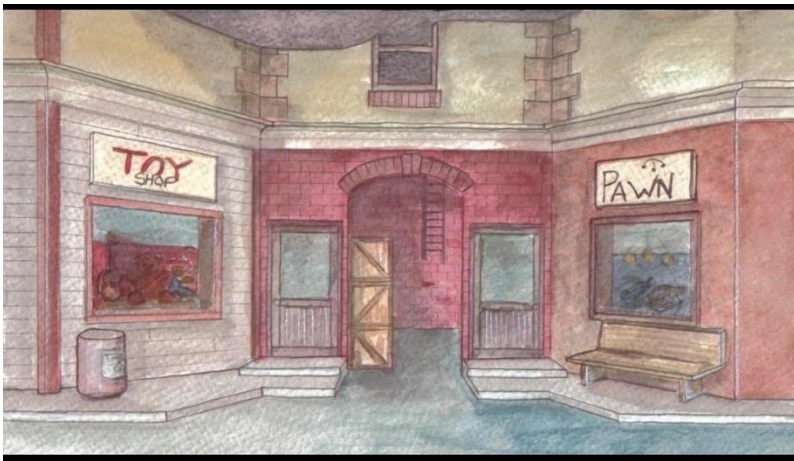
The title of the play is "***The True Meaning of Christmas***" written and with Music/Lyrics by our very own Dion Denevan!
